BUNKER TO BUNKER

It has been a very busy couple of months as spring weather has arrived. The weather has still had its ups and downs, but at least they are tolerable...outside of our heavy storms we have been experiencing off and on.

The drain tile project on #13 has made a huge improvement to the area. We have hydroseeded the area and a lot of seedlings have emerged. They were slow to emerge and grow as our temperatures and weather have fluctuated so much. The seed needs more like 60 and 70 degree days with sunshine and night time temperatures to not drop below 50. We have had some issue with some of the seeded areas as we lost some seed after the storm we had a few weeks ago that dropped almost 3" of rain and about 2" of that in a short time frame. This heavy rain wash away some of the seeds. We have re-seeded the areas that need it.

The course has come out of winter in great shape and growing fast. Aerification went great for the greens. We spiked our greens and lightly topdressed them and rolled them. This will help break up the subsoils a little and allow for better plant growth.

I am asking for the members help. We are seeing more and more ball marks on greens that are not getting repaired. It seems like each year it gets worse. We repair the ball marks in the morning before we mow because if we don't, the mower will scalp the spot and will take much longer to heal. It does take us longer to mow when we have to spend so much time fixing ball marks, but it is the golfers that play behind other play that are inconvenienced when they have to deal with ball marks. When I first started playing the game many, many, many years ago, I was taught by the pro in my first lesson to repair not only my ball mark, but a couple more. That way greens are smooth for everybody if we fix our ball marks and repair our divots.

Got a great season ahead of us and anxious for some great weather and lots of golf!


Mother's Day is shaping up to be another great Member Event for everyone, make sure to make your reservations now!
